**Domaine Ste. Michelle Blanc de Blancs, Columbia Valley, Washington 2008 \$29**

*100% Chardonnay grape. Dry crisp acidity with subtle minerality.*

**Charles Heidsieck Brut Reserve, France 2008 ½ Bottle \$48**

*Baked apple and peach. Lengthy, honeyed finish.*

**Momo Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough, New Zealand 2009 \$35**

*The palate is textural and rich with ripe tropical fruit and grapefruit.*

*The finish is crisp and dry.*

**Cakebread Chardonnay Napa Valley, California 2009 \$72**

*Subtle vanilla with toasty nuances highlighting pear, pineapple and melon fruit flavors set in a supple, discreet oak structure.*

**Chimney Rock Elevage Blanc, Napa Valley, California 2007 \$65**

*Aromas of passion fruit, sensual mouth feel and an exhilarating aftertaste.*

**Illumination Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley, California 2009 \$69**

*Bright citrus, aromas of herbs and an intriguing steely note.*

**Morgon Cote du Py, Beaujolais, France 2009 \$62**

*Aromas of cherry and raspberry, offering complex and enjoyable flavors.*

**Fogdog Pinot Noir, Sonoma Coast, California 2008 \$58**

*Spicy fruit with broad tannins finishing with mouth coating richness.*

**Bearboat Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley, California 2007 \$46**

*Moderately intense aromas of strawberry and vanilla notes. Balanced acidity and soft tannins.*

**Nickel and Nickel Harris Merlot, Napa Valley, CA 2007 \$62**

*French oak integrates with the fruit; dark berries and spice.*

**Brazin Monte Rosso Zinfandel, Sonoma Valley, CA 2007 \$61**

*Rich aromas of black pepper, blackberry and dried spices. Hints of creamy vanilla and spice with bold blackberry jam carries through to the finish.*

**Trinchero Cabernet Sauvignon Haystack, Napa, CA 2007 \$85**

*Gracefully balanced by luscious, ripe black fruit flavors, subtle nuances of coffee and cocoa aromas and a plush, long finish.*

**ZD Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California 2008 \$81**

*The core of ripe fruit integrates beautifully with subtle hints of vanilla, clove and mocha, and the lush silky tannins round out the long, rich finish.*

**Faust Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley, California 2007 \$87**

*Bold and powerful, yet elegant fruit and concentrated finish.*

**Cade Estate Cabernet Sauvignon, Howell Mt., CA 2007 \$103**

*Aromas of black cherry, minerals, warm chocolate and black currants are followed on the palate with flavors blackberry puree, chocolate, vanilla.*

**Kuleto Estate Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, CA 2006 \$82**

*Aromas of black plum skins, toasted oak, and tar. With a little air, cassis and red licorice become dominate. The tannins are focused, linear, and very long.*

**Chalk Hill Estate Red Sonoma Valley, California 2008 \$91**

*Deep, dark and dense. A compelling bouquet packed with cherries, cassis, blackberries and cardamom.*

**Far Niente Cabernet Sauvignon Oakville, California 2007 \$121**

*Intense aromas of blackberry and boysenberry with licorice and perfume.*

**Gaja Ca'Marcanda Promis, Tuscany, Italy 2008 \$85**

*Juicy, silky and sweet, with highly nuanced flavors of ripe red and dark berries complicated by aromatic herbs and flowers.*

**Black Bart's Bounty Syrah, Napa Valley, California 2007 \$127**

*Lovely aromas of violets, blueberry, licorice, and white pepper. Intense flavors of olallieberry and black berry with lingering hints of red raspberry.*

**Stag's Leap Hands of Time, Napa Valley, CA 2009 \$64**

*Vibrant red fruit flavors precede cocoa and nutmeg that lead to a vanilla and spicy finish.*

**Two Hands Gnarley Dudes Shiraz, Barossa Valley, Australia 2008 \$67**

*Intense bouquet of chestnut, currant, chocolate and spice. Initially sweet, supple, then bone dry finishing nicely.*
